Setting up Supplies

Please write your child's name on notebooks, folders, clipboard, and supply box. Please label the divider tabs as follows: class information, Q_1 , Q_2 , Q_3 , and Q_4 .

Binders: Your child will use two binders this year. One of the binders will go home daily and the components of the OCEAN binder are listed below. The other binder will contain our math curriculum and remain at school each day.

The OCEAN binder will be our daily binder that will be carried to and from school <u>EVERYDAY</u>! O.C.E.A.N. is an acronym for <u>Organized</u> <u>Communication Every Achiever Needs</u>. The OCEAN binder will help your child stay organized and facilitate personal responsibility for his/her learning. It will also help keep you in touch with our classroom and your child's academic journey throughout our third grade year.

How?

The OCEAN binder has different sections that will help your child stay organized throughout the year. In each section you will find "homework helpers" to help reinforce skills learned at school. These resources will be added periodically throughout the year as new concepts and strategies are taught and learned.
